from 10 to 16 June 2013, from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm.

The REdesign+ project is aimed at the development and implementation of re-use design products to be realized through the employment of people who are at a disadvantage on the job market.

The **REdesign+ Award** is presented for the second time to honour a previously unrealized design using waste materials.

In each of the four categories – **Mobility & Public Space, Household & Domestic Life, Accessories & Give-aways, and Jewellery & Fashion** – a prize money of 1,000 euros will be awarded.

One of the four shortlisted designs will receive the grand prize, the REdesign+ Award 2013, which is linked to the realization of the product through a socio-economic enterprise.

All of the selected entries will be publicly displayed in Vienna. In addition, they will be presented within the framework of the **VOLT Festival**, taking place this year from **3 to 6 July in Sopron**, the town of the project partner.

This idea contest has been organized within the framework of the Cross-border Co-operation Programme Austria-Hungary 2007–2013.
